A Trusted Track Record

Filling The Void is a 501c3 nonprofit with a 20-year track record that feeds and cares for the hungry, the homeless, the hurting and those who need healing. The organization has received two national awards for community service and been nominated for an Oklahoma Business Ethics Award.

A Labor of Love

Kelly Swan is the founder and president of Filling The Void. Since the organization's inception he has volunteered more than 500 hours per year – raising \$1.5 million in revenue, feeding 350,000 people, training other leaders and expanding the organization into multiple cities and states.

A Turning Point

Kelly traded his career in energy at age 49 to formally pursue the growth and development of Filling The Void. He is expanding its capacity to reach more people, enter more cities, recruit new volunteers, raise up the next generation of leaders and focus on building the organization's long-term sustainability.

The Right Results

Over the past two years, Filling The Void dramatically increased its meals served by 69% and its outreaches by 25% under Kelly's leadership. He also began organizing service projects for schools and strengthening the ministry's board of directors in each of its cities.

A Strategic Decision

While Filling The Void has been a lean mean machine with zero paid staff since its start, the board of directors opted to hire its founder to serve full-time starting in 2023. Kelly's performance metrics and salary are governed by a 5-person independent governance committee.

Seeking Partners

Filling The Void is seeking partners to help sponsor Kelly's compensation of \$4,500 per month. This amount is based on data from non-profit salary surveys that compare organizational size/revenues and the title/responsibilities of its top leader.
